

Harland Sanders Café and Museum –The First KFC listed on the National Register of Historic Places. You have probably passed by this historic location many times and have not taken the time to stop and take a look around. KFC's pioneered by Colonel Harland Sanders, has grown to become one of the largest quick service food services systems in the world. In 1930, the then 40-year old Sanders was operating a service station in Corbin, Kentucky, and it was there that he began cooking for hungry travelers who stopped for gas, He didn't have a restaurant yet, so patrons ate from his own dining table in the station's humble living quarters. As more people started coming strictly for the food, he

moved across the street to increase his capacity. Over the next decade, he perfected his secret blend of 11 herbs and spices and the basic cooking technique that is still used today.
